Moved by Representative Goyke and seconded by Representative Taylor to approve the Juvenile Corrections Grant Committee's statewide plan recommending that the grant applications from Brown, Dane, Milwaukee and Racine counties be approved for awards totaling \$110,960,000 under the Juvenile Corrections Grant Program.
