May 6, 2021

Co-Chair Marklein presided and called the meeting to order.

Department of Health Services

Moved by Representative Born and seconded by Senator Felzkowski to approve the Mendota Juvenile Treatment Center expansion construction project, as described in the department's request submitted to the Committee on October 16, 2019, with a project enumeration of \$65,955,200 as requested for the 2021-23 building program, funded with existing general fund supported bonding.

[Secretary's Note: The enumeration for the project was set at \$58,994,000 in 2019 Wisconsin Act 9 and \$43,994,000 of bonding was specifically authorized to fund this project. The Governor's veto message relating to Act 9 indicated his intention was that \$15,000,000 of bonding authorized to fund a "Center" would be allocated to this project. This motion would be consistent with an increase in the project enumeration of \$6,961,200 from Act 9, and would utilize: (a) the \$43,994,000 of bonding specifically authorized for this project; (b) the \$15,000,000 of "Center" bonding; and (c) \$6,961,200 of the \$25,000,000 of "Projects" bonding and related enumeration that resulted from the partial veto of Act 9 to fund this additional amount. The State Controller's Office March report on general obligation status indicates that \$15,000,000 of "Center" bonding and \$18,000,000 of "Projects" bonding remains available.]
